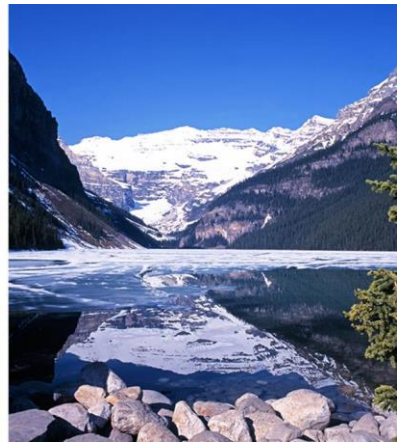

Day 1: Thursday, February 9, 2017 Edmonton, Alberta - Tour Begins

Upon arrival, visit a local ammonite specialist to learn about this rare gem found only in southern Alberta. Afterwards, enjoy time to browse the quaint shops in the village. Later,

arrive at the "Castle in the Rockies," the Fairmont Banff Springs. Settle in for a two-night stay before embarking on a historic tour of the property, originally built in 1888 as a railway hotel for adventurous travelers crossing the Rockies. Learn about the famous people and events linked to this grand icon. Later, retire to your room with a breathtaking valley view. (B)

Day 6: Tuesday, February 14, 2017

Banff This morning, enjoy some leisure time in charming Banff. Explore the heritage buildings, shop for unique gifts or visit local museums. **This afternoon, set off on a horse-drawn sleigh ride*!** Feel like you have stepped into a holiday card as you traverse the countryside. Next, warm up by the fire as you sip hot cocoa and roast marshmallows. Join your fellow travelers at a farewell dinner where you will toast the end of a wonderful trip. (B, D)

Experience It! The Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel

Travel back to a time when only the wealthy and adventurous journeyed to the Canadian Rockies as you settle in for a two-night stay at The Fairmont Banff Springs. Get to know this hotel's rich history when a hotel expert leads you on a tour of this historic property. Originally built in 1888, it was destroyed by a fire and rebuilt in 1926. After a few expansions, it has spawned the nickname "Castle in the Rockies" for its grand presence with pointed roof peaks and a stone façade. In the 1930s, the hotel was teeming with heads of state and actors that included Queen Elizabeth, King George VI, Benny Goodman and Marilyn Monroe. Even today you may catch a glimpse of a familiar face strolling through the halls.
