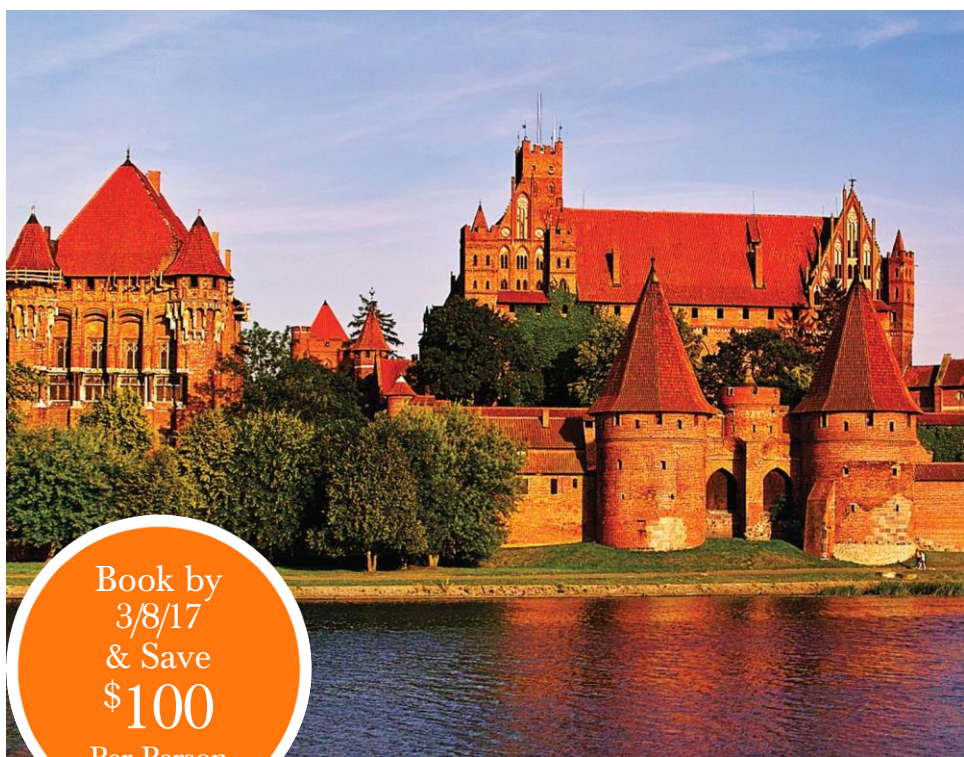

Day 1: Thursday, September 7, 2017

Overnight Flight Your journey through Poland, a land of amazing castles, poignant history and welcoming culture, begins with an overnight flight.

Day 2: Friday, September 8, 2017

Warsaw, Poland - Tour Begins

Welcome to Warsaw! The city has a blend of old-world charm and a modern energy. Tonight, join your fellow passengers for a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 3: Saturday, September 9, 2017

Warsaw Embrace the moving history of Warsaw, a city reborn after WWII, as you embark on a locally guided tour. Your journey through this capital city includes a stop at what remains of the Warsaw Ghetto. The afternoon is at leisure to take in the alleyways, the quaint cafés in Warsaw's Old Town, explore a museum or simply relax. (B)

Day 4: Sunday, September 10, 2017

Warsaw - Czestochowa - Krakow

Travel south to Krakow, an enchanting city famous for its well-



preserved town center. En route, stop in Czestochowa, the spiritual capital of Poland, where each year over 5 million pilgrims journey to pay their respects to the famous Black Madonna. Housed in the Jasna Góra monastery, journey inside for an up-close look at this miraculous image. Arriving in Krakow, enjoy some free time to get acquainted with the city. This evening you are introduced to traditional Polish culture during a folklore show and dinner, complete with wine and beer. *(B, D)*

Day 5: Monday, September 11, 2017

Krakow This morning we explore the city on a tour with a local expert that includes visits to Market Square, St. Mary's Church and the university. You will also see the famous Wawel Castle, the former residence of Polish kings. The rest of your day is at leisure. Perhaps you'll stroll the quaint side streets of Krakow's famous Old Town, have coffee in one of the largest squares in Europe or walk along the river for views of the new sections of the city. You may also visit the Schindler Museum or join your fellow travelers on an optional excursion. *(B)*

Day 6: Tuesday, September 12, 2017
Krakow - Auschwitz - Wroclaw Today you **embark on a poignant journey through history as you travel to Auschwitz.** A local expert guides you through the former concentration camp where you will learn firsthand about the terrors as well as the resilience of the human spirit that occurred within those walls. Later this afternoon, arrive in the ancient city of Wroclaw. Tonight, join your traveling companions for some locally-brewed beer and a traditional "home-style" dinner at a local restaurant. *(B, D)*

Day 7: Wednesday, September 13, 2017
Wroclaw A morning tour of Wroclaw brings you up close and personal to this large and ethnically diverse city. It could be the only location where you can find a Stare Miasto (Old Town) with a Synagogue, a Lutheran church, a Roman Catholic church and an Eastern Orthodox church standing near each other. The remainder of the day is at leisure to savor Wroclaw's idyllic parks and captivating culture. *(B)*



Day 8: Thursday, September 14, 2017

Wroclaw - Torun Today you travel to the town of Torun, a UNESCO World Heritage site and birthplace of Nicolaus Copernicus, the famous astronomer. Torun remains one of the best-preserved medieval towns in all of Europe and is one of the “Seven Wonders of Poland.” On arrival, walk past Copernicus’s house before stepping back into history while baking and sampling your very own gingerbread according to a 500-year-old recipe. (B)

Day 9: Friday, September 15, 2017

Torun - Gdansk This morning, join a local expert for a walking tour of this unspoiled town. Next, travel to the port city of Gdansk. Make a stop at the Gdansk Shipyards, site of the creation of the anti-Communist Solidarity movement in 1980 that helped liberate Poland from Soviet rule. (B, D)

Day 10: Saturday, September 16, 2017

Gdansk - Choice of Activity This morning, join a local expert for an introduction to this strategic and remarkable city. Get to know its deep

history on your tour which highlights City Hall and St. Mary’s Church. Later, the choice is yours. Perhaps you will choose to join your Tour Manager on an excursion to the seaside resort town of Sopot. Or, perhaps you’ll choose to remain in Gdansk and join a local guide on an educational shopping excursion during which you’ll learn about Polish amber at a demonstration, followed by the opportunity to purchase the stone. The evening is at leisure. Perhaps you will take a stroll through a beautiful square, shop for local handicrafts or soak in the seaside atmosphere. (B)

Day 11: Sunday, September 17, 2017

Gdansk - Marienburg Fortress - Warsaw Your journey through Poland comes full circle with your return to Warsaw. En route, stop in the town of Malbork, home to Marienburg Fortress, the largest castle in the world. **A guided tour of this 700-year-old structure introduces you to the world of the Knights of the Teutonic Order.** This evening, join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner celebrating a fantastic journey. (B, D)

Day 12: Monday, September 18, 2017
Warsaw - Tour Ends Your tour comes to a close today. (B)

Experience It! Torun

Torun was founded in 1244 by the Teutonic Knights and today is a UNESCO World Heritage site with many architectural structures dating from the early Middle Ages. The city is famous for having preserved almost perfectly its medieval layout. Numerous brick buildings built in the Gothic style still exist, including churches, the Town Hall and burgher houses which surround the old town. Torun, unlike many other historic cities in Poland, escaped destruction during World War II. Particularly left intact was Old Town, whose important architectural monuments are originals, not reconstructions. Torun is the birthplace of Copernicus and the home where he was born is still intact today.

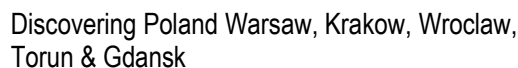

Krakow**Wieliczka Salt Mines****\$50 USD**

Venture outside of Krakow to one of Poland's most fascinating locations, the magical Wieliczka Salt Mines. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is the only mining site in the world that has been functioning continuously since the Middle Ages. Lying on nine levels, its original excavations (longitudinals, traverses, chambers, lakes, as well as minor and major shafts) stretch for an incredible 300 kilometers. Meet a miner guide who will take you down into this spectacular maze of unique rooms, tunnels, chapels and salt statues. It's an adventure unlike any other. Please note that this excursion requires a large amount of walking. *Duration: Approximately 4 hours.* Please note a minimum of 15 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Wroclaw**Church of Peace & Countryside Dinner****\$85 USD**

Travel through the Silesian heartland to the towns of Jawor and Swidnica, home to the "Churches of Peace." You will visit one of these churches whose names are derived from the Peace Accords of Westphalia signed in 1648 which ended the 30 Years War and which permitted Lutherans living in Catholic Silesia to build their own evangelical churches. We will explore the church which has been named a UNESCO World Heritage site due to its masterful architecture and historical importance. Inside you will be treated to a private organ concert. Afterwards, you will journey to a small village in the heart of the countryside where you will enjoy a feast in a countryside restaurant. *Duration: Approximately 6.5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 15 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
